




This is my library – The West Des Moines Public Library!






If I want to walk through the full building before I visit, I can use the <u>virtual tour</u> above!

# Library Living Room








The library living room is a good place for a snack!

## Storyroom






Sometimes we read stories together in the Storyroom. You can even walk through the small door!



#### Teen Center







If I'm between the ages of 12 and 18, I can be in the Teen Center. I can study, gather, and read books here. I can ask the Teen Librarian a question.










Teens can reserve a study room on the first floor in the Teen Center to study and gather.










I can use the catalog to find the items I need.

Or I can use the stairs.




### Adult Services Desk

The second floor has lots of books for adults. This is a quiet area.










It also has movies!
