Activity!

Muffin Tin Sort

You will need a muffin tin, milk or juice lids, crayons, hair ties, legos, and/or small toys

Your child can sort by color, size, type of item, and/or number order (one item in one cup, two in the next cup, three in the next, and so on). If you wanted to add color to the bottom of a muffin tin for your child to match the item to, just cut out a colored circle and lay in the bottom of the cup. Another idea is to write a number on a piece of paper, cut out in a circle that will fit the cup, and then your child can put as many items as the number says into that muffin cup.

This activity strengthens your child's fine motor (small movements) skills, hand and eye coordination, their pincer grasp (thumb to pointer finger), works on identifying and differentiating between colors, and sorting skills!
