

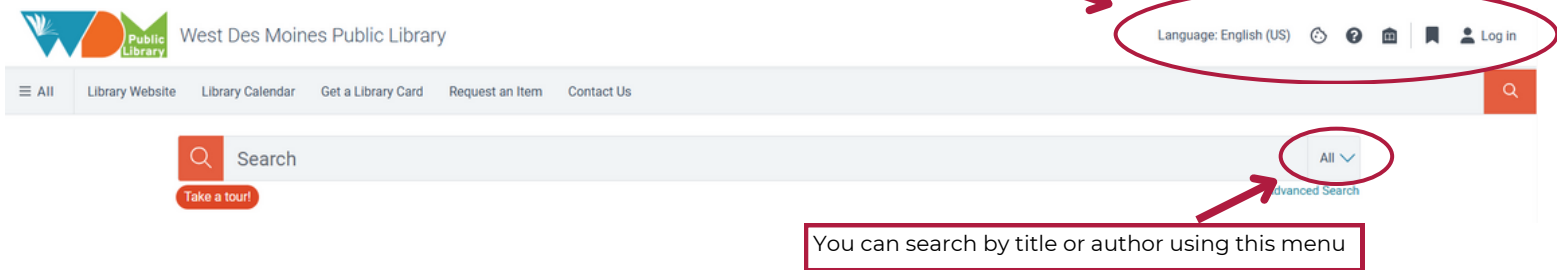

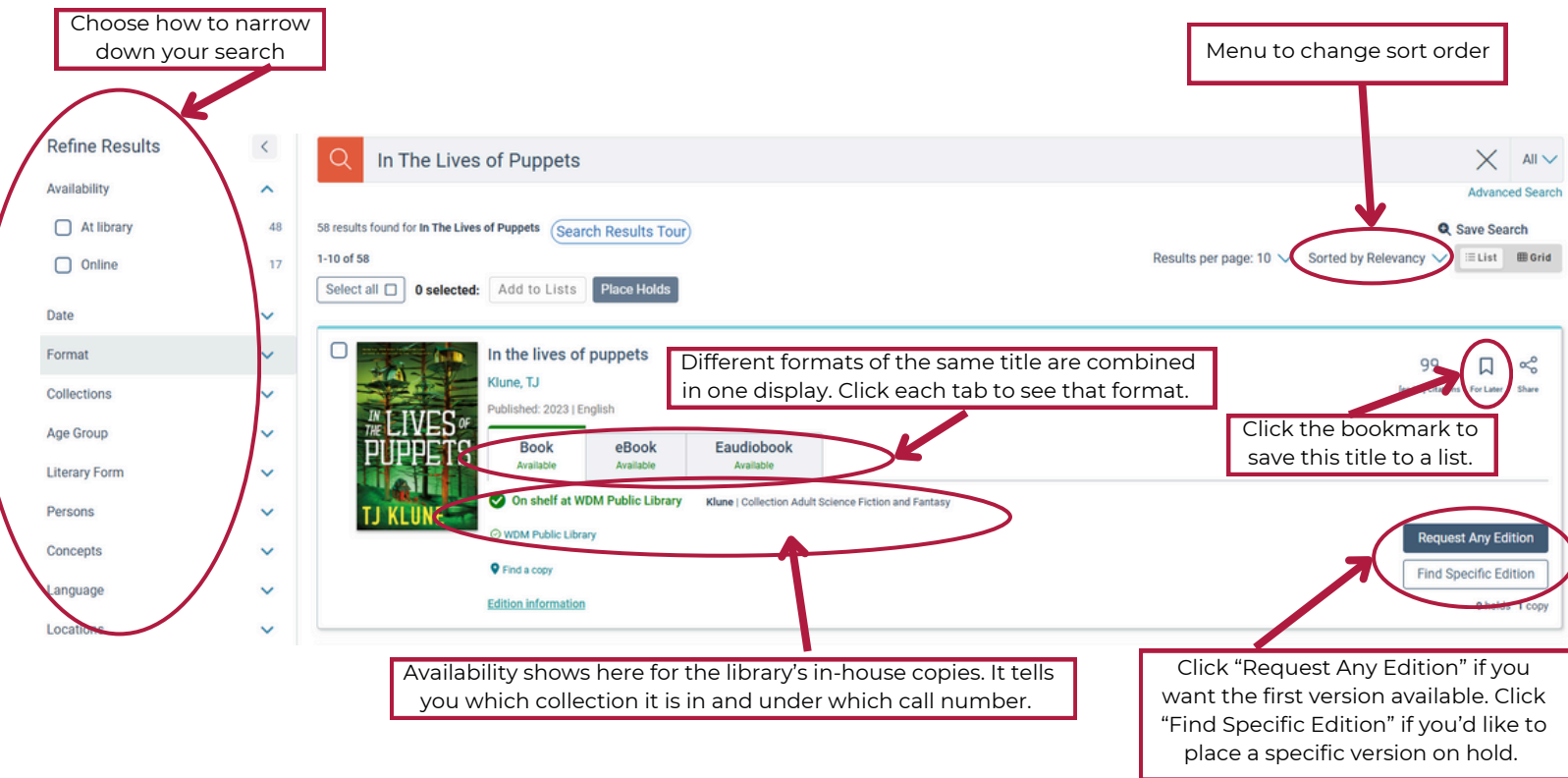
The new catalog's homepage is user-friendly and easy to navigate.

Buttons left to right: Change Language; Manage Cookie Preferences, Help, Library Info | Open bookmarks (see below), Log in to my account



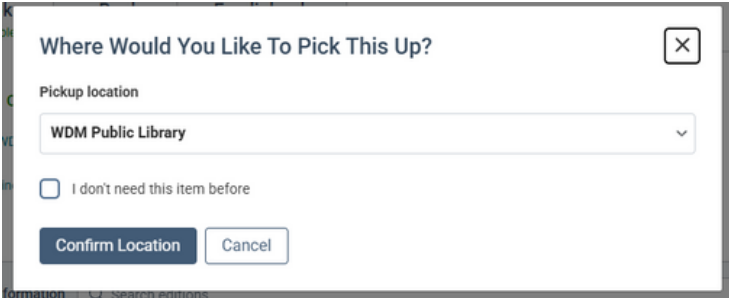
Search Results
